- Cooked a meal
- Washed and Dried Laundry
- Held a job
- Completed High School
- Written a check
- Planned a budget
- Attended College or Certification Courses
- Held an in-depth conversation
- Had to provide for themselves

The Dwelling Place Program

The Dwelling Place Program is the beginning of a major life transition for the women who will come to our home. Step one is for their healing and safety. It is only the start for these women, as they continue to grow and rebuild relationships they will move to the next step in our program.

STEP TWO - EDUCATION & SKILLS

Step two of our Dwelling Place Program will continue to provide Biblical therapy and counseling and will include teaching basic skills to help them be successful when they enter back into the community.

NSM will come along side the women helping them complete their GED and/or Continuing Education or Certification courses to help improve their chances of finding employment.

They will learn basic housekeeping skills, meal planning/cooking, sewing, how to budget and balance a checking account and many more skills that we may take for granted.

Social skills will be play an important role and may be one of the biggest challenges some of them may face. Social skills may include any of the following:

- → Attention & Concentration—focuses on a sustained effort of doing activities without distraction & the ability to hold that effort long enough to complete the task
- ⇒ Receptive Language— is the comprehension/understanding of language
- ⇒ Expressive Language— is using language through speaking or other avenues to communicate wants, needs, thoughts and ideas
- ⇒ Pre-language—focuses on how we communicate without using words, such as gestures, facial expressions, eye-contact
- ⇒ Self Regulation—is our ability to obtain, maintain & change one's emotions, behaviors, attention and activity levels which are appropriate for a task or situation in a socially acceptable manner
- ⇒ Executive Functioning—focuses on the higher order reasoning and thinking skills
- ⇒ Planning & Sequencing—this will help them figure out the sequential multi-step task or processes to achieve a well-defined result

Human Trafficking in KANSAS

It's hard to think that you could live in an area where there is human trafficking, especially here in Kansas, after all it only happens in large cities, bigger states or overseas, Right....WRONG. This form of modern day slavery is happening in every state even KANSAS!

SIGNALS are the contacts that the hotline receives, this can be tips or reports

Since 2007 the

National Human Trafficking Hotline

has received 2,605 signals of trafficking in Kansas.

- Hotline Calls = 2,007
- Online Reports = 225
- Web Chats = 26
- SMS Reports = 319
- Email Received = 28
