WHAT DOES THE BIBLE TEACH ABOUT TRAFFICKING

Joseph. Do you remember him? You can read the account of his life beginning in Genesis chapter 37. Joseph: the child who was **SOLD** to the Egyptians by his brothers. Joseph: the child who was **SOLD** to be a **SLAVE**. Joseph's brothers were guilty of human trafficking and Joseph was the victim. Simply put, human trafficking is slavery. Experts have noted that human trafficking is the fastest growing criminal activity in the world and one of the most lucrative.

God values human life. Genesis 1:26 records for us that when God created humans, He created them in His image. Human trafficking is a humiliating insult against humans who have been created in God's image. Luke 4:18 guides us in setting free the oppressed. Christ came to earth as a perfect and holy sacrifice for ALL who are oppressed. This includes those who have been or are being trafficked and those who are trafficking people. This includes you and me. As a result of sin all of mankind is oppressed.

Our ONLY hope is in Christ alone.

The reality is this: it happens all across this country. From big cities to small towns, it is everywhere. Where there is demand, supply is created.

What can you do? Continue to educate yourself. Spread awareness. Support ministries that are meeting the needs of victims. Be AWARE. Be ALERT. LISTEN to those God brings in your path.
